Instructions

1. Do **not** use any tables or calculators.
2. Use a **separate** sheet for each problem and write on only one side. If you require two or more pages for your work, place the extra pages at the **end** of your submitted pages.
3. Write darkly enough for your work to be scanned.
4. Write the problem number clearly in the upper-left hand corner for each page.
5. Each problem is graded on a basis of zero to ten points. Partial credit will be given for significant progress toward a solution.
6. At the end, give this sheet and the six pages (one page for each problem, in order – additional pages should be at the bottom of your stack) to your contest supervisor. You may keep the problem sheet.
7. It is your responsibility to make sure your pages are in order.

Example Submission: A student answers problem 1 on two sheets, does not answer problem 2, answers problems 3, 4, and 5 on one sheet each, and problem 6 is on three pages, then the student would stack the papers in the following way:

- the individual registration form on top
- the first page of the solution for problem 1
- blank page for problem 2
- the pages for the solutions of problems 3, 4, and 5
- the first page of problem 6
- the remaining pages, starting with the second page for problem 1 followed by the two pages for problem 6
